




3 Steps Toward Disability-Inclusive Climate Action

Disability-Inclusive ACTION




Events, information & campaigns should be **disability-inclusive and accessible** at global, regional and national levels.



COP26 must lead by example, ensuring a fully accessible and inclusive event.

Disability-Inclusive PARTICIPATION



Organizations of persons with disabilities should be involved as **stakeholders in climate change negotiations** at global and national levels.



Organizations working on climate change should be inclusive of youth, women and indigenous persons with disabilities.

Disability-Inclusive DATA and FUNDING



Data on the impact of climate change on persons with disabilities should be collected and disaggregated.



Climate funding should be **disability-inclusive** and disability funding should address climate change.
